**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that AmTrust Europe Limited (**AEL**) and AmTrust International Underwriters dac (**AIU**) and AmTrust Assicurazioni s.p.a. (**AmTrust Italy**) presented an application to the Business and Property Courts of England and Wales, Companies Court in London (the **Application**) pursuant to Part VII of the UK Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 (the **Act**) for Orders:

- (1) under section 111 of the Act sanctioning a scheme (the **Scheme**) providing for the transfer (the **Transfer**) to:
  - a) AmTrust Italy of all of AEL's Italian medical malpractice business (which includes any additional forms of coverage under medical malpractice policies) (the **Medmal Business**); and
  - b) AIU of all of the general insurance and reinsurance business (other than Medmal Business) situated in the European Economic Area excluding the UK (the **EEA30**) written and/or assumed by AEL from the UK and through AEL's branches in Italy and Sweden (and where only part of a policy relates to the EEA30, only that part of the policy will transfer); and
- (2) making ancillary provisions in connection with the Scheme pursuant to sections 112 and 112A of the Act.

The Application was heard before Mr Justice Snowden on 24 July 2020 and 29 July 2020 and the Orders sanctioning the Scheme and making ancillary provision in connection with the Scheme were granted. Pursuant to the Orders granted by Mr Justice Snowden, the Scheme became effective at 23:59 BST on 31 July 2020.

In addition to any right to cancel provided for in the terms of any policy included in the Transfer, if your insurance policy is included in the Transfer, and the risk to which it relates is situated in an EEA State other than the United Kingdom, the laws of the EEA State concerned may give you a right to cancel your policy as a result of the Scheme. If you have such a right, you must exercise this right within 30 days starting from the date hereof or (if different) within the time limit specified by the laws of such EEA State.
